Material condition YOKE (modified) is set. Boilers #2 and #4 and ships service generators #2 and #4 are in use. SOPA is Commanding Officer USS BOSTON (CAG-1). 0100 C/C to 338. 0127 C/S to 14 knots.

Commenced maneuvering on various courses and speeds to take station astern of USS CANBERRA (CAG-2) on course 090, speed 10. 1040 Commenced approach to port side of USS CANBERRA (CAG-2). 1050 First line over. 1058 Commenced passing three unknown war dead to USS CANBERRA (CAG-2). 1105 Completed passing war dead. 1109 All lines clear. Commenced maneuvering on various courses and speeds to clear USS CANBERRA (CAG-2). 1110 C/C to 252. 1113 C/S to 16 knots. 1146 C/C to 255. 1150 C/C to 256.
