We need volunteers to help set up, hand out flowers, and tear down our setup for the Public Wreath Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington National Cemetery.

We need volunteers on 8, 9, and 10 Nov. You can volunteer for each day or for a part of one or more of the days.

- Monday, 8 Nov
  - 1100-1600
  - Receive delivery of flowers, prepare flowers for distribution, and queue them at Tomb of the Unknown Soldier
  - Gather equipment (tables, etc.) and queue them at Tomb
  - Nice work clothes
- Tuesday, 9 Nov
  - Two shifts
    - Morning 0630-1230
      - Set up and be ready not later than 0730
      - Distribute flowers
    - Afternoon 1200-1800
      - Distribute flowers
      - Tear down
  - Can make accommodations for school aged volunteers
  - Nice clothing suited for weather
- Wednesday, 10 Nov
  - Two shifts
    - Morning 0630-1230
      - Set up and be ready not later than 0730
      - Distribute flowers
    - Afternoon 1200-1800
      - Distribute flowers
      - Tear down
      - Return equipment
  - Can make accommodations for school aged volunteers
  - Nice clothing suited for weather

We will provide a distinctive nametag for volunteers to wear while working

Volunteers park at Arlington Cemetery public parking garage; we will shuttle to and from the Tomb
